Now that we have moved directly from summer to winter I am reminded that it is time for me to focus on what I am grateful for. When I do, I don't have to look any further than this past month at Lodi Primary School to appreciate being a part of such a wonderful school and community.

Another successful PTO chocolate sale has wrapped up and the PTO earned a nice amount to donate to the schools. Thank you to all that contributed in some way! The Lodi area firefighters donated a full day of their time to teach fire safety to all Primary and Elementary students. We are lucky to have high school students, parents, and retired volunteers that contribute their time and talents in the classrooms daily. Teachers and specialists planned hikes to the Ice Age trail for all kindergarten through fifth grade students. Kindergarten teachers provided their classes with the unique experience of learning about nature and teamwork out at the School Forest. October concluded with a successful 4K Fall Fest and the 2nd annual PTO Fall Fest Dance where approximately \$1,300 was earned for Heritage Park. I don't know of any other school that has such dedicated staff members and experiences so much support from their community. This was especially demonstrated at the Halloween Parade this week as well as the other functions we had occurring at the Primary School this month.

We strive to teach our students that they are part of this school and the greater Lodi community. Our students are already learning about community service. They spent time making projects and writing stories to be displayed at the Lodi Women's Club Library event held at the Waddle Inn. First and Second grade students have partnered up with kindergarten and 4K students to mentor them for the school year. Second grade students took their Halloween parade out to the local nursing homes to sing them songs, show them their costumes and spread some Halloween spirit. The Primary School students will be bringing in food items to stock the shelves at Reach Out Lodi in time for the holidays. Mrs. Chambers is organizing the Scholastic Book Fair that will be open during parent teacher conferences to provide the opportunity for families to purchase books and also supply several free books for each classroom.

I am grateful for all of this support for our students. We are all very lucky to be part of this great community that cares for more than just themselves. What are you lucky to have or to be part of? Let that person or group know with a "Thank You."

Dear Parents and Guardians,

As the weather is getting colder it is time to be talking to the kids about how to dress to be outside. We recognize each child is an individual and needs different attire to stay comfortable at various temperatures. Before heading outside teachers tell the students what the weather is like and may advise them about what might be the best choice of clothing. We then will be allowing students to choose what they would like to wear outside. Children will be told that once they are outside they have to stay outside so they should put on the clothes that they think they will need. We do not have extra warm weather clothing supplies at school so be sure that you send the warm



weather attire and extra dry clothing that your student may need. Much of our playground is not plowed during the winter so when there is snow on the ground many students like to have boots and snow pants. Our goal is to increase the children's independence and to hold them accountable for making their own decisions about what is comfortable for them. Children

will be kept inside when the temperature or windchill are below zero.

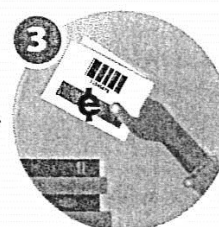

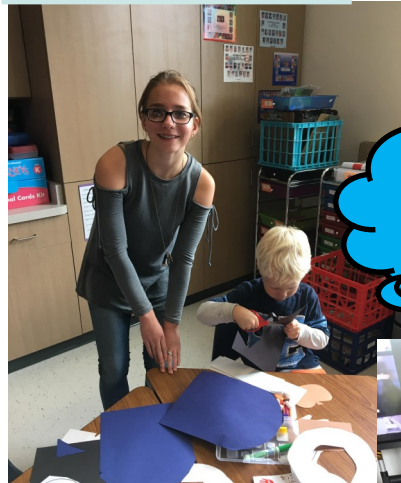

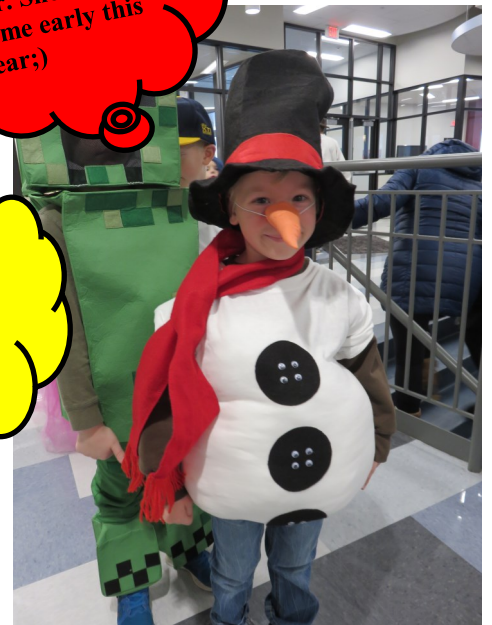
